The sites were visited as follows:

Gorham Beach Park:

Ruts and gravel disbursed onto grounds by snow removal trucks (Antrim County Road Commission)

DNR is no longer replacing signage and check to verify that kiosk can be taken down

Other than issues stated above the park is in good shape.

Intermediate Lake/Snowflake Road Ending:

Fencing – replace up to twelve (12) dog-ear slats.

Torch Lake Family Park:

Pull back rocks to support bank and shore line on the left side of the dock.

Several birch and ash trees need to be removed.

620 Road Ending/Meeders:

Water's edge and rocks need to be pulled back to support shoreline.

Jacob's Road Ending:

Quite Area Signage needed replacing and fence repair needed.

Pinnel Road Ending:

Fence Repair

Steiner Road Ending/Sunset Torch Condo:

Shoreline stabilization steps area.

Set Picnic table near grill.

Dockside Road Ending:

DNR/Dewey Boat Launch:

Arrowhead Park:

Add mulch to pathway and move fence sections to make a contiguous line near road to prevent vehicle entry.

Replace one section of fencing

Add mulch around trees and under picnic tables.

Trim large pine tree at entrance to see Township signs.

Replace fence with a removable style pipe system.

Lynn Road Ending/Lake Bellaire:

No major issues in good shape.

Lessard Lane Road Ending:

Corey will continue to observe.

In good shape – no repairs needed.

Loon Preserve:

Fencing needs to be secured to straighten and tree limb needs to be cut down.
