A letter from the Antrim County Road Commission was received regarding the possibility of future applications of brine on gravel roads within the township incurring a charge. The commission is no longer able to obtain the brine at no cost, as they have done in prior years.

A letter from the County Treasurer regarding tax foreclosed parcels available for purchase by the township was discussed. The Board will need to make a decision regarding the property at their July meeting.
