The Board discussed a proposal for a pavilion to be built at Glacial Hills, submitted by Parks & Recreation Commission Chairman, Carrie Hebden. The Board decided to table the proposal until a future meeting with the commission.

Motion by Crandall to approve the Minutes of the October 3, 2019 Board Meeting. Seconded by Steiner and carried.

Motion by Steiner to approve expenditures in the amount of \$18,501.14. Seconded by Crandall and carried.

Treasurer's Report was given.

Planning Commission Update: Short Term rentals, as well as 'Small Houses' were discussed. The Commission discussed sending out a Survey to all property owners of record to solicit their input on various issues that the commission is working on.

Parks & Recreation Commission/Glacial Hills Update: The commission will be discussing a proposal from Paddle Open concerning signage at access sites.
