Regular Meeting

December 6, 2018

Meeting called to order at 7:00 P.M.

Motion by Steiner to approve the Agenda. Seconded by Kent and carried.

Public Comment:

Sheriff's written report was distributed to members.

Representatives from Cedar Meadows Association addressed the Board, requesting the Township to assume the electricity cost of street lights located within Cedar Meadows. Supervisor Smith explained the history behind the current arrangement. In early to mid 1970's, the Association requested the Township's assistance in acquiring street lighting for their area. The Township agreed, with the stipulation that the Association would assume the cost of electricity for the lights, to be paid annually. It was determined that there would be no change in the current arrangement.

Motion by Steiner to approve the 2019 Meeting Calendar. Seconded by Crandall and carried.

Supervisor Smith informed the Board that Steve Osborn as been appointed to the Glacial Hills Board, replacing Bud Ferguson, who has retired.

Motion by Crandall to approve the Minutes of the November 1, 2018 Board Meeting. Seconded by Kent and carried.

Motion by Kent to approve expenses for October, 2018 in the amount of \$18,533.67. Seconded by Crandall and carried.

Motion by Crandall to approve expenses for November, 2018 in the amount of \$28,118.61. Seconded by Kent and carried.

Treasurer's Reports was given.

Planning Commission Update: The Board approved the building of a ten foot fence on a Deer Form on Honey Hollow Rd.

The Board approved their 2019 Meeting Calendar.

Parks & Recreation Commission/Glacial Hills Update: Currently in 'winter mode', discussing plans for next season.

Supervisor Smith informed the Board that he is currently exploring options for an easement to property recently purchased adjacent to the Soccer Park.
