Public Comment:

Master Gardener, Sue Haadsma-Svensson addressed the Board regarding the issue of Invasive Species at Glacial Hills. She outlined a strategy that could be used to eliminate those species that are harmful to the environment and humans, one being garlic mustard which is spreading.

The Plan is to map the area where these species have been found and remove them. The Board agreed to assist in this effort by approving the plan, assist in raising volunteers to perform the plant eradication, and assist financially in the purchase of trash bags, etc., and the cost of removal of the bags.

Supervisor Smith explained the benefits to residents of having our township initiate the process of becoming eligible for Flood Plain Insurance. The Board agreed to begin this process.

Motion by Steiner to approve the Minutes of the 09-03-2020 Meeting. Seconded by Crandall and carried.

Motion by Crandall to approve the expenditures in the amount of \$25,195.39. Seconded by Steiner and carried.
